- 15.1 The Landlord may make such deductions from the Deposit as are reasonable should the Landlord suffer any loss as a result of the Tenant breach of the terms of the Agreement. This includes:
 - 15.1.1 Reasonable costs and compensation where the property and contents are returned in a less favourable condition than given at the beginning of the tenancy (subject to fair wear and tear)
 - 15.1.2 Non-payment of any rent or interest on any amount, which was not paid when it was lawfully due
 - 15.1.3 Non-payment of any utility bills (including reconnection charges) or Council Tax bills relating to the property
 - 15.1.4 Reasonable costs of sending reminder letters and other costs associated with processing defaulting payments such as uncleared cheques, failed standing orders or similar
 - 15.1.5 The Tenants allow overcrowding that results in non compliance with the number of allowed occupants or fines for the Landlord
 - 15.1.6 Loss associated with the breach of any restrictive covenants to which the Property is subject
 - 15.1.7 Reasonable costs for replacing alarm codes or keys or and locks on failure to return codes or keys
 - 15.1.8 Reasonable costs and compensation where the Tenant unreasonably or wilfully obstructs the Landlord or his Agents or Contractors from performing their repair and maintenance obligations
 - 15.1.9 Any Insurance excess if the claim was as a result of the failure of the Tenant or someone the Tenant had invited into the Property to act reasonably
 - 15.1.10 Reasonable costs of the Landlord securing possession where the Tenant has failed to comply with a lawful notice to leave the property or where they leave earlier than the Tenancy Agreement permits
 - 15.1.11 Reasonable costs for the disposal, removal, replacement and/or storage of items, which are left at the premises at the end of the tenancy
 - 15.1.12 Costs incurred where the property has to be re-let when the tenants has vacated earlier than the contract end date.
 - 15.1.13 The cost of the rent guarantee insurance if the tenant vacates the property earlier than the contract end date at the cost of £350.00
 - 15.1.14 Any costs incurred by the landlord if the tenant vacates the property earlier than contract end date up until a new tenant is found and has moved into the property
 - 15.1.15 All keys must be returned to the Landlord/Agent this includes any extra keys cut at the end of the tenancy by 6.00pm. If the keys are not returned or the Landlord/Agent believes there are extra keys which have not been returned then the tenant agrees the sum of £150.00 will be taken from the deposit to allow the Landlord/Agent to change the locks at the property.
